

Minutes of October 7th KMHC meeting:

Kansas Miniature Horse Club met on October 7, 2007 at the home of Kathy and Wayne Gillett in McLouth, Kansas. The gathering started with a potluck lunch.

The meeting began at 2:10pm.

Marsha Mendenhall, KMHC President opened the meeting with roll call. Members introduced themselves to the group. 13 members attended the meeting.

More old business included confirmation that the form signed by members to petition the ending of balding show horses was sent to AMHA.

The training tapes were tabled by Mike Shove to the next meeting.

New Business:

Discussion led to the conclusion that there was not enough time to accomplish a fall driving clinic in 2007. Sharon White-Lewis will find a date for a spring driving clinic in their area.

Mike Shove suggested having the club purchase a toner cartridge and paper to allow him to print the newsletter at home. A one time cost of these might be enough to cover the entire 2008 newsletters. This has been tabled until the December meeting.
